The whole Principality will be transformed into a grand gallery space, by well-known institutions: Francis Bacon MB Art Foundation; the Museums of Chagall, Picasso and Leger; Artcurial Auction House, and many others.

## **FRANCIS BACON MB ART FOUNDATION**

This Foundation is dedicated to promoting a deeper understanding of Francis Bacon's art, life and working practice, with a particular focus on the time the artist lived and worked in Monaco and France.

Bacon lived and worked in Monaco from July 1946 to the early 1950s. Throughout his life the artist frequently returned to the Principality, staying for extensive periods together with his family, lovers and circle of friends. He managed to accomplish many work there, despite many distractions (i.e. casino).

Francis Bacon MB Art Foundation opens its doors to general public only once a year during Monaco Art Week. It's a chance to see the masterpieces they have collected over the years.

## THE FITZGERALD RIVIERA

Discover the villa where Fitzgerald wrote *Tender is the Night*, beach where Picasso painted some of the most well-known work from 20s – 30s, the casino in Juan Les Pins where Fitzgerald sabotaged Hemingway's honorary party & the ballroom where Marlene Dietrich seduced Kennedies – both the father and the president-to-be son. These were talents, personalities, storytellers who created the myth of the French Riviera. By coming here in the end of April you will be ahead of tourists, being able to enjoy the place in the same calm pace and luxurious atmosphere as they did.

Locations include Monaco, Cap Ferrat, Antibes, Cap d'Antibes, Juan Les Pins, Cannes. The tours involve a lot of walking and talking to artists, aristocrats, and local personalities in cafes and restaurants.
